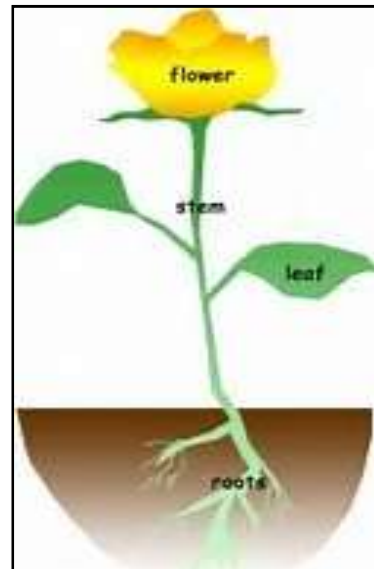

A plant	A living thing that usually grows from the ground.
The main parts of a plant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flowers</li> <li>• Leaves</li> <li>• Stem</li> <li>• Roots</li> </ul>
4 common plants to identify	Daisy Daffodils Dandelion Foxgloves Buttercup
Plants (Trees)	
The main parts of a tree	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crown</li> <li>• Leaves</li> <li>• Twigs</li> <li>• Branches</li> <li>• Trunk</li> <li>• Roots</li> </ul>
4 common trees to know	Horse Chestnut Sycamore Silver Birch Oak

Spelling	Definition/Sentence
